Male Participants to change into uniforms at the **Level 3, Chinese Museum in Cohen Place**, Must be changed and assigned position by 9.15 a.m. for the Chinese New Year Parade and changed.

Female Participants to change on **Level 2 at the Chinese Museum in Cohen Place**.

Eligibility:

Due to the Association being required to have "a duty of care" to its Participants, it restricts participation to:

- Boys & girls over 12 years to carry weapons, banners and lanterns;
- Boys & men over 16 years old to be the 'Legs' of the Dragon;
- Or if the Committee's Representatives, in their judgement, deem any applicant unsuitable to participate.

Uniforms:

All uniforms will be issued to all Participants (except footwear).

Please come wearing **white** runners.

Lunch:

Lunch will be provided free of charge to **Participants only** after the parade. Should your partners, parents or friends wish to join you in the meal, a subsidised charge of \$15.00 is payable.
